FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed PowerTubs™ + Minerals free-choice to beef cattle on all types of roughages. Feed one tub per 20 head of cattle. Cattle should consume approximately 1 to 3 pounds per head per day. If animals consume more or less than the desired amount, reposition the tubs to achieve the proper consumption. Factors affecting consumption are variations in forage quality and availability of such forages. After initial adjustment period of 7 to 10 days from tub introduction, average consumption will be 1 to 3 pounds per head per day.

Additional free-choice mineral should be fed along with PowerTubs™ + Minerals. Average Selenium consumption should not exceed the legal maximum of 3 mg per head per day. Each pound of PowerTubs™ + Minerals contains 0.96 mg of Selenium.

Do not feed to sheep or goats due to high copper levels.
